Morning

In Arcachon

- Explore on foot or by bike the seafront from the port to the Moulleau Pier.
- Or discover, with a guide or on Le Petit Train d'Arcachon (the little train), the Ville d'Hiver (Winter City), a historic area with its lavish villas from the 19th century.

Alternoon

The Dune of Pilat (located in La Teste de Buch)

- Come explore the entire length of the sand dune (2.9km). Return by walking along the beach to discover a magnificent unmarked path.
- Take advantage of nature activities all year long, meet at the Dune Info Point (+33 5 66 22 12 85).
- Or take to the sky by paragliding!



Confirm suggestions and visits with one of our Tourist Offices as schedule: vary during the week.



Morning The oyster-farming villages of the Lège-Cap Ferret peninsula

Take a bike ride through the fishing district with a stop at the Cap Ferret Lighthouse or the oyster-farming villages of l'Herbe and Canon to taste a couple oysters. Getting there: Take a water taxi or a shuttle that leaves regularly from Arcachon or Andernos-les-Brins

Atternoon Tour l'île aux Oiseaux (Bird Island)

This is where you will see the famous Cabanes tchanquées (stilted cabins)!

Because a sea kayak can pass anywhere, it is the best way to get up close to this protected area. Or board a boat trip leaving from the piers of Bélisaire, Andernos-les-Bains or Arcachon (all year long), or from Le Canon (in July and August).



Morning
The bird watching reserve of Le Teich

Take a walk on a 2.5km or 6km trail, dotted with observation huts. 300,000 birds, from 260 different species, pass here each year.

Visits on your own or with a guide, during the day or at twilight (+33 5 24733733).

Afternoon
The Leyre river and its delta

The Leyre river and its delta (Le Teich, Biganos et Mios)

Discover on foot, by bike, in a canoe-kayak, or even in a boat. Along the ports of Biganos, by stand up paddle or electric boat (no license required) from the port of Teich.

At the end of the day, enjoy a soirée guinguette (food, drinks, music and more) in Mios on the banks of the Leyre.



At dawn

In front of the sunshine

Soak up the morning light and enjoy breakfast on a terrace.

MorningDiscover our oyster ports

On foot or by bike, stroll among the colorful wooden cabins of the ports of Gujan-Mestras and visit the Oyster House (Maison de l'huître museum) at the port of Larros to learn all about the pearl of the Bay (+33 5 56 66 23 71).

Alternoon

Embark with fishermen and oyster farmers aboard their boats

Departures according to the tides.

Book directly with authorized seafaring professionals: the list is available at the Maison de l'Huître (port of Larros, in Gujan-Mestras) or at the Bay's Tourist Offices.



Morning

Exploring the Bay on foot or by bike

- In addition to the guided walking tours offered by the Tourist Offices, you can get the guidebook «Le Tour du Bassin à pied» (9.90 €) to discover our GR (Grandes Randonnées) hiking trail. This tour of the Bay takes you along the coastal path, the well known Saint-Jacques-de-Compostelle road, the oyster ports and many other remarkable sites ...
- Discover the towns of the Bay thanks to a network of more than 220 km of bicycle paths.

Afternoon Jump in the water!

- More than 40 km of beaches on the open ocean (Grand Crohot in Lège-Cap Ferret, la Salie in La Teste-de-Buch...). Ideal for embracing the waves!
- Or calmly on the sandy beaches of the Bay at high tide or on Lake Cazaux.
- In Le Teich, Audenge, Lanton and Arès, marked swimming areas are supervised. Ideal when the tide is low!

Afternoon

Have fun in our attraction and theme parks!

Gujan-Mestras Bassin des Loisirs (Aqualand, la Coccinelle, Kid Parc, Max'Golf, Bassin Aventures, Bowling, Laser Lander); Escalad'Parc (rock climbing) and Mégazone (Laser games etc...) in Andernos-les-Bains; Parc de Loisirs du Four in Lège-Cap-Ferret; Go Karting in Biganos; Zoo du Bassin d'Arcachon in the Teste de Buch; Padel Touch in La Teste de Buch, or even T en Leyre (rope course), and Lakecity in Mios.

- In the heart of the marshlands and salt meadows of La Teste du Buch.or at the Domaine de Fleury in Le Teich, in the Domaines de Certes-Graveyron in Audenge and Lanton, in Saint-Brice-Les-Ouinconces in Andernos-les-Bains and Arès, at the Réservoirs of Piraillan, in the Réserve des Prés Salés (salt marsh reserves) of Arès and Lège.
- Crab fishing in Lanton, in the heart of the Bay!
